Is Veterans Home Care Covered by Insurance?

Yes — home care is covered by Medicare, Medicaid, the VA, and most private insurance companies.

VA benefits may vary. In general, benefits for combat or wartime vets are not based on income. However, the eligibility of peacetime veterans may be income based.

To qualify, veterans must have received an honorable, other than honorable, or medical discharge. In most cases, they must have been on active duty for at least 24 months.
